#### What to Pack

Some of our events will require being outdoors, so please plan accordingly for early fall weather (cooler mornings and evenings while being warmer during the day) and potential muddy grounds.

    - After dinner on both nights, we have activities that will require clothes that you're able to move in easily such as golf, bowling, and axe throwing.
- I'd recommend bringing a Jacket and/or sweatshirt, rain jacket, and extra sneakers depending on the activity you selected

#### **FAQ**

#### What's expected of me while on the retreat?

Just as on any normal day, all team members are expected to bring their whole selves to work. You're expected to be on time, participative, engaged, and respectful of all fellow team members. This will be a work hard/ play hard retreat, but please remember to remain professional and respectful of each other.

#### How do I reimburse my travel expenses for the retreat?

#### What COVID protocols are we taking?

As a team, we all need to take responsibility for keeping each other and ourselves safe. All team members will be required to test negative for COVID-19 using an at-home test within 24 hours of leaving for the retreat. If you test positive or are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms prior to the retreat, please contact Kathleen Herrmann immediately.

Please note that COVID tests are no longer covered by our insurance. You can acquire at-home tests through a few means which can be found on the <a href="Express Scripts website">Express Scripts website</a>.

We currently have a "mask optional" policy. However, please feel free to do what makes you feel safe and comfortable to be able to participate in our retreat. Whether that means wearing a mask or not, know that we support everyone making the best decisions for themselves without any questions.

#### Can I bring a 'plus one' on the retreat?

The retreat is strictly for AWeber team members. This gives us, as a team, dedicated time to form deeper connections as well as opportunities to strategize within our departments.

#### I have a food allergy - how will I ensure that I get the correct food?

We have alerted the Nemacolin staff of all dietary restrictions so their kitchen is aware, but you will still be responsible for letting their waitstaff know about any of your dietary restrictions during each meal.

#### What time do I need to arrive at Nemacolin?

All team members should plan to arrive at Nemacolin by 4pm on Wednesday, 10/23 to check into your rooms and explore the property. Depending on room occupancy the night before, you might be able to check into your room earlier.

If you arrive before 4pm, you are also welcome to enjoy all property amenities while waiting for the rest of the team to arrive.

#### Do I need to tip for any services on the retreat?
